My User Experience

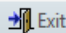
My User Experience allows user the opportunity to switch between different roles in Cerner. This change will assist you to meet your needs for your job roles and responsibilities, *i.e. ED Nurse and Med-Surg Nurse* (see below for position based listings).

Key Benefits:

- Allows identified users to change their role and their view in Cerner.
- Permits just in time changes of your role for efficiency.
- Minimal work to change your user role and functionality.

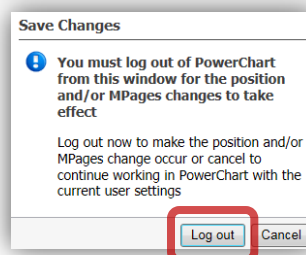
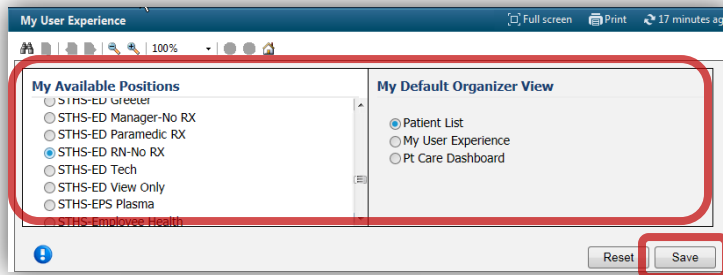


To Get Access: Your Manager will need to request access via AAS. Once access has been granted users can change their positions within PowerChart, SurgiNet, and FirstNet.

Note: You may need to rebuild your Patient list, I-View bands, or Multi Patient List properties the first time you use this. Make sure to exit out of the **Exit door** icon () after setting your filters, this will save your changes.

To Get Started: Sign into PowerChart and click on the **My User Experience** icon inside the toolbar. If you don't see the icon, click on the dropdown button () to locate the application – **My User Experience**.

- a) A list of the available positions for the user will be listed on the left under **My Available Positions**. Select a position.
- b) On the right, a user can also change the default view when opening up within the application.
- c) Click **Save** after change(s) have been made.
- d) A pop-up window appears to remind users to log out of the application for the change to take place. Click **Log out** to continue.



Note 1: If you are changing your Cerner position and don't see the expected access, please log out of Cerner completely.

Note 2: If you are accessing Cerner through Cerner application icon, you must click on **zzzz Cerner Session Cleanup** icon. This will close all your Cerner applications.
